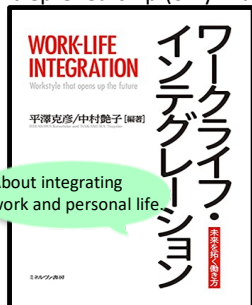

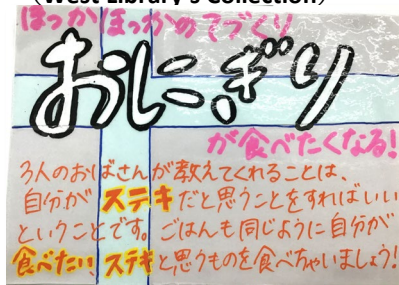
Dai Kanwa Jiten (which currently has a simultaneous view limit of 10) will not change. We will see the viewing conditions and consider adding more views for next year.

We are also preparing a display for these books using POP cards! Please look forward to seeing what books were chosen.



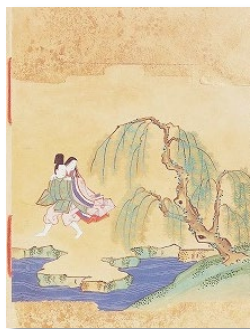

This Month's Antique Book



『Ise Monogatari』 (Nara Ehon)

Central Library Valuable Materials Collection

A Nara ehon (picture book) is a manuscript that was written from around the end of the Muromachi Period until the middle of the Edo Period. The term "Nara ehon" comes from the theory that these books were made as a side business for Buddhist image craftsmen near Nara Kofukuji Temple, though there are many other theories as well. In the early days they were called simple, artless picture books, but as time went by they became bigger and more extravagant in their bindings. They are also known as "bride books", or books taken by brides (usually princesses) to their new homes as a gift to their new family.

『Ise Monogatari』 is a Heian-period poetry tale which follows the life of a protagonist, who was based on Ariwara Narihira, from his coming-of-age until his death, told in a combination of beautifully flowing prose and waka poetry. Well known sections include the tale in which the protagonist spirits his love away, only for her to be eaten in one bite by an Oni near the shores of the Akutagawa river, and the tale of the protagonist falling in love with his childhood friend as they played near a well curb "Tsutsuidutsu".
