Illustrated Explanation of Exercise and Health for Young Children

Early Meiji Period – Textbook Collection (Central Library Rare Materials Room)

This was an educational resource for early childhood learning at home, clearly emphasizing the importance of daily physical activity. Such illustrations were known as "Educational Nishiki-e", and were created during the early Meiji era, when the government began establishing a formal school education system.
